




Client – Manual

This little Manual will give you a little tutorial on how to use the Fox-Talk Client.

Step 1 (All needed files):

> *Check if your Client-Folder looks like this and has Full-Write-Rights!*




RED – Needed files to run the Fox-Talk Client

YELLOW – Files and Folders that will be created during the execution of the Client

GREEN – optional files

Step 2 (first Start):

1. Place the License-file from the Server in the directory of the client.
2. Make sure to start the Client with administration rights!










